



## Trends in Four Land-based Activities (1960 – 2000/06) in millions




## Trends in Four Water/Snow-based Activities (1960 – 2000/06) in millions




# Participation in 10 most popular activities (% of US adults in 1982/83)




# Participation in 10 most popular activities (% of US adults in 2000/06)




### Fastest growing activities from 1982 to 2006 (in millions)



### Fastest growing activities from 1982 to 2006 (% change)




### Slowest growing activities from 1982 to 2006 (in millions)




### Seven slowest growing activities from 1982 to 2006 (% change)




### % Participation by Gender (2006)




### % Participation by Race (2006)




### % Participation by Age (2006)
